Additional Comments: I'm gathering ballpark pricing for a church website in the Sacramento area. Not a formal proposal at this stage — a rough range is all I need.

Scope:

~12–15 pages, fully bilingual with a Spanish/English toggle. Spanish is the default, properly translated rather than a Google Translate overlay — including forms, checkout, and confirmation emails.

Sermon video archive that syncs automatically from an existing YouTube channel.

A professionally shot silent looping hero video for the home page. No usable footage exists, so it would need to be filmed — please quote half-day and full-day.

Online registration with card payment for three recurring annual events: a family camp priced per family, and two one-day conferences priced per person. Capacity limits and a waitlist. It has to be reusable, so staff can set up next year's

event themselves. Cash and check payments taken in person need to land in the same roster as online ones.
Recurring online giving and tithing: one-time and recurring donations, ACH alongside cards, deposited directly into the church's bank account, designated funds, and automatic year-end contribution statements.
An ongoing maintenance plan.
The two questions that matter most to me:

The site currently runs on GoDaddy Website Builder. Can this be built there? If not, just say so and tell me what blocks it — plus what you'd recommend instead, with annual platform and license fees stated separately from your maintenance fee.

Stripe or Square for both the event payments and the giving — which do you recommend, and why? I'm aware Square has no nonprofit rate, and that year-end contribution statements out of Square usually mean manual exports.

If you can, split the range into: base site / bilingual + translation / video archive / hero video shoot / event registration + payments / recurring giving / monthly maintenance / annual license fees. Rough numbers are completely fine.

One last thing: is setting up each year's events included in your maintenance plan, or billed per event?

Happy to send a detailed written scope if this looks like a fit.
